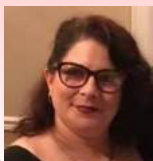
Meet Our Newest Princesses

A pamphlet given with the shawl includes the Prayer of Comfort which reads in part "May you find comfort from all that appears too much to bear at this moment...May this prayer shawl be a shelter for time of overwhelming grief... May you be comforted by the presence of those who love and support you". As members of Daughters of the Nile, we vow to assist fellow members when their burdens become too heavy - to take a part of their load and bear it for them. When we wrap a fellow Princess in a Prayer Shawl, we want them to feel the love and support from the Temple embracing them.

We're looking for people to create the shawls to give out. There isn't a specific pattern. It just needs to be approximately a 2 ft by 5 ft rectangle. And if you're not an expert "crafter", no worries. And if in making the Prayer Shawl you make a few mistakes or drop a few stitches - that's okay. Our love is still knit therein.
