**SUPREME TEMPLE DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE
SUPREME TEMPLE ANNUAL SESSION 2019 – RENO, NEVADA
LEGISLATION RESULTS TO THE SUPREME TEMPLE BYLAWS AND SUBORDINATE TEMPLE BYLAWS
AND UPDATES TO THE RITUAL, PROTOCOL, AND MANUAL OF PROCEDURES**

Please be aware of the changes made to the Supreme Temple Daughters of the Nile Bylaws (2013.3 Revision) by the voting Delegates at the Supreme Temple One Hundred Third Annual Supreme Session in Reno, Nevada. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

I. PARTS I AND II OF THE SUPREME TEMPLE AND SUBORDINATE TEMPLE BYLAWS

Amendment R-1 to PART I, ARTICLE I SOVEREIGNTY AND ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, SECTION 8. DISSOLUTION, third paragraph [page S-5]. As adopted, SECTION 8., third paragraph, now reads:

SECTION 8. Dissolution

The Canadian Endowment Funds shall continue to be distributed annually and equally to Shriners Hospitals for Children® in Canada.

Amendment R-2 to PART II, ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 1. Eligibility (a) [page SB-6], which would have expanded membership eligibility to include a personal friend of a Daughter of the Nile was defeated.

Amendment R-3 to PART I, ARTICLE IV, SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1. Standing Committees, (e) Convention Committee [page S-29]. As adopted, SECTION 1. (e) now reads:

(e) Convention Committee shall be composed of one (1) Past Supreme Queen to serve as Chairman and at least four (4) members, including one (1) member who is proficient in working with computers and audio-visual concepts and one (1) member who is knowledgeable in the duties of the convention management system.

The Chairman shall:

- 1. Negotiate contracts for the Voting Devices and the Online Registration Program.*
- 2. Submit a report at each meeting of the Board of Directors and the Annual Session.*

The Committee shall:

- 1. Provide guidelines to Candidates running for the office of Supreme Princess Badoura.*
- 2. Become an information center for all materials for the Supreme Elective Line Officers.*
- 3. Assist with competitive negotiation of contracts with the Supreme Session hostess city chosen by the Supreme Princess Badoura.*
- 4. Provide assistance with details in planning the convention, including:
 - a. Training for the Supreme Session registration management system.*
 - b. Requirements for audio-visual needs.*
 - c. List of the Supreme Session Committees and their duties.*
 - d. Templates for Supreme Session publications.**
- 5. Maintain and update the Supreme Temple Appointment Database.*

Amendment R-4 to PART I, ARTICLE IV SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION 1. Standing Committees (h) Financial Review Committee [page S-31]. As adopted, SECTION 1. (h) now reads:

(h) Financial Review Committee shall be composed of one (1) Past Supreme Queen to serve as Chairman and two (2) members of Daughters of the Nile who shall review the financial records and processes used in the Offices of the Supreme Princess Recorder and Supreme Princess Banker.

The Financial Review Committee shall:

- 1. Review monthly from the Supreme Princess Recorder and Supreme Princess Banker:
 - a. Reconciliation Detail including Beginning Balance, Cleared Transactions of Checks and Payments, Deposits and Credits, Uncleared Transactions, and Ending Balance for each bank account.*
 - b. Reconciliation Summary for each bank account.**
- 2. Review monthly from the Supreme Princess Banker:
 - a. The Checks Written Reports.*
 - b. The Deposit Reports, including date(s) and amount(s) per bank account.*
 - c. Detail of Current Liabilities of the Bank Control Account (Credit Card) entries.*
 - d. The Reconciled Bank Statement for each bank account.*
 - e. The monthly Profit & Loss and Balance Sheet Reports.**
- 3. The Financial Review Committee shall report its findings to the Delegates at each Annual Session.*

Amendment R-5 to PART II, ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP, SECTION 9. Initiation Fee, Annual Dues, and Membership Card [page SB-8], which would have exempted former patients of Shriners Hospitals for Children® from paying Initiation Fees and Annual Dues was defeated.

Amendment R-6 to PART II, ARTICLE IX, CLUBS [page SB-36]. As adopted, the current wording was formatted into SECTION I. **United States and Canada** and a new SECTION 2. **Other International Countries** was added and now reads:

SECTION 2. Other International Countries

- (a) *The Supreme Queen shall authorize the Chairman of the International Development Committee to contact eligible ladies in an international city to confirm interest in resident women in becoming members of Daughters of the Nile.*
- (b) *If women in an international city wish to form a Club, the Supreme Queen, in consultation with the Chairman of the Supreme Temple International Development Committee, shall select a Subordinate Temple to sponsor the Club in the international city.*
- (c) *The Queen of the Subordinate Temple, under the directions of the Chairman of the International Development Committee, shall appoint a Chairman and two (2) members who shall serve as liaison between the sponsoring Temple and the Club leaders by sharing information about Daughters of the Nile, answering questions, and making acquaintance with the interested ladies in order to propose new members.*
- (d) *The Chairman and committee members shall propose for membership in Daughters of the Nile at least two (2) eligible ladies who reside in the international area and the sponsoring Temple shall successfully ballot on their proposals.*
- (e) *The sponsoring Temple shall initiate the Petitioners in person or via telecommunications software products for video chatting between computers.*
- (f) *The new international members shall seek permission from the Temple to form a Club.*
- (g) *The sponsoring Temple shall provide the Club with the Articles of Incorporation, Supreme Temple Bylaws, Manual of Procedures, Protocol, Ritual of Daughters of the Nile, and Daughters of the Nile Floor Charts for Subordinate Temples.*
- (h) *Translation of the above-named Supreme Temple publications shall be the responsibility of the Club and such translated publications shall be submitted to the International Development Committee for verification.*
- (i) *The Club shall follow the laws and procedures regarding Clubs found in the Subordinate Temple Bylaws, Part II, Article IX. Clubs and in the Manual of Procedures, Section XIII. Clubs.*
- (j) *The International Club members shall propose additional women who are eligible to become members of the sponsoring Temple and Club in accordance with the Supreme Temple Bylaws.*
- (k) *Additional Club members may be initiated into the Daughters of the Nile in an Obligation Only Ceremony via telecommunications software products for video chatting between computers. The Obligation shall be translated and repeated in the language spoken by the Candidates. The full Ceremony of Initiation shall be performed when possible.*
- (l) *The Queen of the Subordinate Temple and the Temple Chairman shall continue to mentor the Club members with the assistance of the Chairman of the Supreme Temple International Development Committee.*
- (m) *The Subordinate Temple Queen may conduct her Club Official Visit via telecommunications software products for video chatting between computers. Club Minutes shall be emailed to the Queen for her signature and a copy shall be sent to the Chairman of the International Development Committee.*
- (n) *On an annual basis at the end of the Foundation Fiscal Year, the Club shall report to their Subordinate Temple and to the Treasurer of the Daughters of the Nile Foundation in the currency of their country and in U.S. currency all monetary donations made for the medical benefit of in-country patients.*

Amendment R-7 to PART I, ARTICLE VI SUPREME TEMPLE FUNDS, SECTION I. Income (c) [page S-38]. As adopted, SECTION I. (c) now reads:

- (c) *For the United States and Canadian Temples, the Annual Per Capita of nine dollars (\$9) in the currency of the country for each member in good standing, including Life Members. Members in other International Countries shall submit Annual Per Capita in U.S. dollars.*

Amendment R-8 to PART I, ARTICLE IV SUPREME TEMPLE COMMITTEES, SECTION I. Standing Committees (a) Action Team Committee [page S-28]. As adopted, SECTION I. (a) now reads:

- (a) *Action Team Committee shall be composed of one (1) Chairman and one (1) Vice-Chairman and at least ten (10) additional members of Daughters of the Nile.
The Action Team Advisory Panel shall be composed of at least two (2) Past Supreme Queens. Supreme Princess Royal shall serve as an ex officio member.*

The Chairman or Vice-Chairman shall:

1. *Review all objectives and communicate with the committee as needed.*
2. *Designate the committee members for regional and Temple support.*
3. *Submit a report at each meeting of the Supreme Temple Board of Directors and the Annual Session of the Supreme Temple including the activities of the committee members.*

The Committee shall:

1. *Be knowledgeable of all Daughters of the Nile publications and have the computer skills to perform the required duties.*
2. *Provide Temple or regional assistance through consultations and/or workshops in every area needed to produce and/or retain a viable Temple.*
3. *Assist the Subordinate Temples with:*
 - a. *Enhancing Nile knowledge and guidance without fear of censure.*
 - b. *Promoting harmony among the members.*

c. *Developing a plan to achieve their goals.*

II. UPDATES TO THE RITUAL

Please be aware of a change to the Ritual (2018 revision) [Page 62], made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Reno, Nevada. This change was effective as of the day enacted.

- ★ At the end of the Obligation, add back the following phrase:
, binding myself under the severe penalty of being suspended or expelled from the Order.

And a change to the Ritual (2018 version) [second and third paragraphs on Page 100] made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Reno, Nevada. This change was effective as of the day enacted.

- ★ (The Queen-elect shall select the Chairman of Installation and the Installing Officers. The Installing Queen(s) shall be the Supreme Queen, Past Supreme Queen(s), Queen or Past Queen(s). The following Installing Officers do not have to be a Past Queen: Princess Marshal, Princess Chaplain, Princess Musician, Attendants, Bible Bearer, and Crown Bearer. An Installing Princess Recorder and/or Princess Banker is/are optional. The Installing Musician does not have to be a member of the Order.)

(Only members of the Order may participate in the written ritualistic Installation Ceremonies. Each Officer-elect and participating member shall have a current Dues Card. The Choir may open the Temple with a musical selection. If desired, additional music may be provided by other musicians and/or soloists, who may or may not be members of the Order.)

Please note that the Supreme Princess Recorder will distribute sticky pages to the Subordinate Temples in order to update the Ritual.

III. UPDATE TO PROTOCOL

Please be aware of a change to Protocol (2013.3 revision), [page P-12], made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Reno, Nevada. This change was effective as of the day enacted.

Section IV. ORDER OF SUBORDINATE TEMPLE INSTALLATION, A. Outline for Subordinate Temple Installation, 17., now reads:

- ★ 17. Call to WRITTEN RITUALISTIC Order by Installing Queen

Please be aware of changes to the Manual of Procedures (2013.3 revision) made by vote of the Board of Directors at the Annual Board Meeting held in Reno, Nevada. These changes were effective as of the day enacted.

★ **SECTION XI. INSTALLATION OF OFFICERS, A. 8.** [page M-125]

8. A printed program should contain all applied steps listed in the Protocol and additional Temple traditions or performances of the Ceremony of Installation. The program must list the names of all Installing Officers.

★ **SECTION XVII. RECORDS RETENTION AND DISPOSAL, 20.** [page M-149]

20. Supreme Temple Annual Proceedings Books: Consists of the official record of the Supreme Temple of each fiscal year. A Subordinate Temple shall keep twenty-five (25) Annual Proceedings Books which would include the last seven (7) years.
