Article V – Section 4(b) (v)

CURRENT WORDING	PROPOSED AMENDMENT	IF ADOPTED WILL READ
One hundred twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to purchase corsages for Past Supreme Queen (s) and Reigning Queen participating in the opening and closing of Supreme Temple	Fifty dollars (\$50.00) to purchase a corsage, with a receipt, for the Reigning Queen participating in the opening and closing of Supreme Temple	

RATIONAL: We no longer have a Past Supreme Queen going to Supreme to purchase a corsage for and the unit going to Supreme purchases a corsage for the Reigning Queen the night that they perform there is no longer a need for the Temple to purchase more than 1 corsage.

Article V – Section 4 (j) 1

CURRENT WORDING	PROPOSED AMENDMENT	IF ADOPTED WILL READ
The Temple shall assist in sending one (1) unit to Supreme Session each year by paying the registration fee provided the unit has performed at all ceremonials and attended at least one (1) Stated Session per year. (approved 3/1/2019)	The Temple shall assist in sending one (1) unit to Supreme Session each year by paying the registration fee provided the unit has performed at all ceremonials and a representative has attended at least four (4) Stated Sessions per year.	

RATIONAL: Change to be the same in number to Standing Rule 8 and adding ‘a representative has’
